For classes IV & V English and Hindi Calligraphy, Antakshari of Words, Slogan Writing on Save Water and Solo Singing Competition provided ample opportunities to learn.

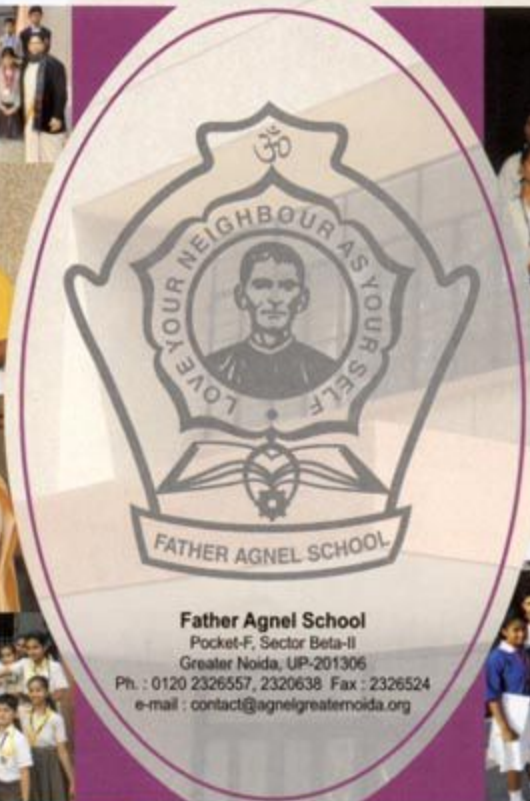
