I went to him and asked, "How are you, Shivam?" Shivam didn't speak anything. I again asked him, "Shivam, are you alright?" And ... I noticed, his eyes were wet. His hands were shaking and his heart was beating fast. I held his hands and pressed gently.and he started sobbing and crying bitterly like a child. I held his face in both my hands and asked again and again the reason but he didn't say anything. I let him cry to his emotions. After some time he was quiet and stopped crying. I again asked him, "What happened?" He answered, "I want to do many things, I try also but I do not get success. Neither I am able to please my parents nor my teachers are happy with me. 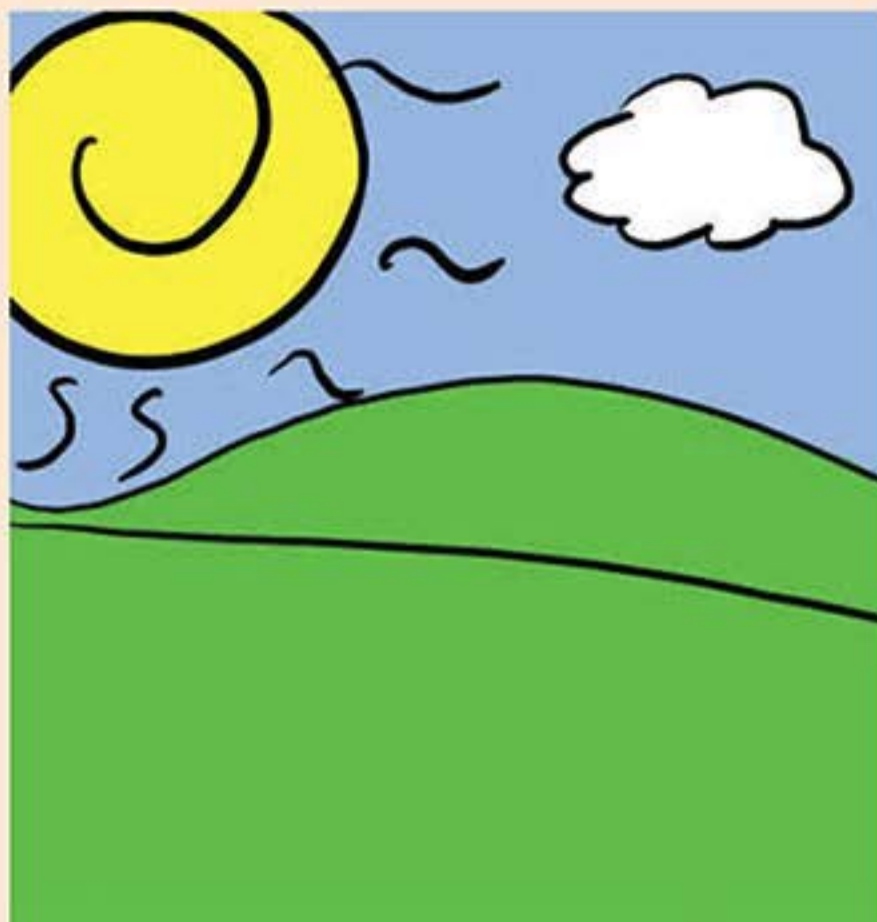
PAINT YOUR NATION IN YOUR COLOURS
